



## Together Everyone Achieves More!

The Town of New-Wes-Valley would like to provide residents an update on funding received for some upcoming projects. Being proactive and applying for funding the town has been successful in obtaining \$2.3 million for the following projects that will commence over the coming months.

- **Watermain Extension**  
(Templeman-Pound Cove) - **\$1.3 Million**
- **Newtown Bridge** - **\$614,000**
- **Water Treatment** - **\$100,000**
- **Paving** (Black Duck Lane, Moores Lane, Tom Sheppards Lane and Sam Sturges Lane) - **\$90,000**
- **Bonavista North Museum** - **\$50,000**
- **Business Pond Walking Trail** - **\$10,000**
- **Solar Street Lights** (Valleyfield Branch) - **\$8000**
- **Beothic Arena** (Compressor Overhaul, Painting, LED Lights, Matting, Female Hockey Program and New Electrical Panel) - **\$84,000**
- **Jaws of Life** - **\$30,000**
- **New Wes Valley Fire Department**  
(Commercial Washer) - **\$5290**

**W**e are pleased to announce with the support of council the office staff was successful in obtaining government funding for all noted projects. By availing of funding opportunities means the town will not have to take on the burden of incurring short/long term debt to fully fund all of these projects.

Through government funding the majority of the time the town is required a cost share ratio of greater than 50%. In the projects noted we are pleased to say with \$2.3 million being invested, the town's contribution will result in long term debt of \$117,000. This is a tremendous savings to our town!!!!

In addition to these projects the town was also successful in obtaining another \$1,614,746 secured for 2021 construction season for upgrades to our water supply. **This is a good news story resulting in almost \$4.0M over a 2 year time frame!!!!!!**



Council and Staff will continue to be financially responsible and we are very happy with this outcome. We would like to thank our partners, MHA Derrick Bragg for the tremendous support we continue to receive and we look forward to collaborating on important issues we are facing in our community.
