



Garbage Collection Fee Policy

In 2018, the Town of New-Wes-Valley implemented a Garbage Collection Fee to all residents of New-Wes-Valley as a result of rising costs from Central Newfoundland Waste Management and increased amounts of garbage from curbside collection.

This fee is charged to all residences with no exceptions for Seasonal or Part-Time residents. The town does not have the resources to police how often a residence is used, therefore it cannot give an exemption based on the amount of time a resident claims to use or not use a property. In areas that service is provided, as in the case with sewer services, that service will be charged whether the resident chooses to avail of the service or not.

An exemption request can be submitted to Council for consideration. All requests must be made in writing no later than June 1st, of the same year. (Verbal requests will not be responded to.) Requests received after this date, will not be considered.

When requesting an exemption, the following information should be included to enable a decision to be made on your file.

1. Date
2. Name
3. Civic Address
4. Rationale as to why the fee should be considered for exemption

Upon receipt of the exemption request a site visit will be completed by the town and a recommendation will be forwarded to Council for consideration.

This policy was adopted by Council at a meeting held on the 15th, Day of June, 2021 and come into effect on the 15th, Day of June, 2021.

All previously adopted "Garbage Collection Policies" for the Town of New-Wes-Valley this 15th, Day of June, 2021 are hereby rescinded.
